We will admire Michelangelo's Pieta and pray at the tombs of St. Peter and Pope St. John Paul II before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight accommodation.

Thursday, May 29, 2025 Naples, Pompeii

After breakfast, we will drive approximately one hour to Pompeii. Our day begins with an excursion to Mount Vesuvius. The trail is about four miles up and back, reaching an elevation of 1,170 meters above sea level, offering stunning views of Vesuvius National Park and the Bay of Naples. After a break for lunch, we will explore the ruins of Pompeii, which were buried under ash from the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D. This well-preserved site provides insight into what was once a vibrant Roman city. Mass will be celebrated at the Shrine of the Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii before returning to our hotel in Naples for dinner and overnight accommodation.

Friday, May 30, 2025

Naples, Capri

Following breakfast at the hotel, we will embark on a memorable ferry ride to the Island of Capri in the Bay of Naples. Known for the ruins of Imperial Roman Villas, the town of Anacapri, and the Blue Grotto (optional), Capri boasts a breathtaking landscape. We will view the famous Faraglioni rock formations and enjoy a free day on the island for strolling, sightseeing, and shopping in the Piazzetta and along the Via Camerelle. Mass will be celebrated at the Church of St. Francis before returning to Naples for dinner and overnight accommodation.

Saturday, May 31, 2025

Naples, Monte Sant'Angelo, San Giovanni Rotondo

After breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and journey through the Gargano Peninsula to visit the Shrine of St. Michael the Archangel in Monte Sant'Angelo. Mass will be celebrated in the grotto where St.

Pope is in Rome. Here, we will receive the 490, 492, and 493. After free time to explore Holy Father's Apostolic Blessing. Pilgrims this charming area, we will continue to our hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo for check-in,

Sunday, June 1, 2025 San Giovanni Rotondo, Salerno

After breakfast at the hotel, we will spend the morning visiting the holy sites associated with Padre Pio's life. In the afternoon, we will depart San Giovanni Rotondo to return to the Mediterranean coast, checking in at our hotel in Salerno for dinner and overnight accommodation.

Monday, June 2, 2025 Amalfi Coast, Positano, Amalfi

After breakfast at the hotel, we will drive along the renowned Amalfi Coast road, stopping in the picturesque town of Positano, known for its narrow, boutique-lined streets. We will then take a boat to Amalfi, where we will celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of St. Andrew and visit his relics and crypt. This day will be filled with spectacular sights and awe-inspiring landscapes. We will return by boat to Salerno for dinner and overnight accommodation. If time permits, we may also view the "Rovello".

Tuesday, June 3, 2025 Sorrento, Castel Gandolfo

After breakfast and check-out, we will continue to Sorrento, approximately a 1.5hour drive. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of Saints Philip and James (the Sorrento Cathedral). Following the service, there will be leisure time to explore Limonoro, Sorrento's main pedestrian street, which is perfect for sampling limoncello and other local liqueurs. After a break for lunch, we will drive to Castel Gandolfo, the summer residence of the popes, where we will enjoy a farewell dinner and spend the night.
